Discussion Questions – Why Not Trust God?

What concepts jumped out to you in this sermon? Was it something new or something tried-and-true that resonates with you?
If there really were such a thing as "Eternal Life Insurance" – a policy you could pay for to ensure you made it through the pearly gates – how much would you being willing to pay? What percent of your earnings would give? After paying that amount, what kind of life would you be left living in this world in the meantime?
Read Numbers 11:18-20. Was it a sin for the Israelites to wish for more variety in their diet? If yes, why did God provide the quail? If no, why was God angry?
Read Numbers 11:21-23 and John 6:5-9. Did Moses or the disciples have enough resources to meet the needs of the people? What were their roles? What did they give? Why does God choose to work through human agency? What lesson does that give for us today?
Read Numbers 11:31-34 and John 6:11-13. In both stories, God supplies more than what was needed. What was the major difference in how the people handled that abundance? How can we apply this lesson to our lives today?
