Discussion Questions – Two Righteous Rich Men

Read 1 Corinthians 10:13 and 1 Timothy 6:9, 10. Do you think that God ever limits our income? Why or why not?
Read the story of Lot found in Genesis 13:8-13, Genesis 14:11, 12, and Genesis 19:1-3 then answer the following questions:
1. Knowing Sodom and Gomorrah were wicked, why did Lot choose to live there?
2. Where was Lot's home in these different verses? Why the change?
Compare the record of Lot (2 Peter 2:7, 8), his wife (Genesis 19: 17, 24-26), and his daughters (Genesis 19:30-32, 36-38). How do you think Lot's tendency to have a self-sufficient worldview impacted the fate of his wife and daughters?
How might Lot's story have been different if he had consulted God before making decisions on where to live, work, and spend his resources? What was the ultimate "cost" of making those choices without God?
