**Discussion Questions – Heart Audit** 

What concepts jumped out to you in this sermon? Was it something new or something tried-and-true that resonates with you?

"Stewardship is not about money, it's about faith." Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not? Do you think the greatest stewards have the greatest faith? Explain.

Read the story of the manna found in Exodus 16:3-7, 14-30 and answer the following:

- 1. What was the Israelites' need? What was their response to their need?
- 2. What was God's response to the need? How much did God provide? (note v.21)

- 3. What was required of the Israelites?
- 4. How much manna was each person supposed to keep?
- 5. What happened if someone kept more than their basic needs?
- 6. What were they supposed to do on Friday and Saturday?
- 7. What kind of journey do you think their faith went through?

What parallels can you draw from the Israelites' experience with manna to our own calling regarding stewardship and faithfulness? Read Deuteronomy 8:16-18.
